Meet Conditions

- 1. Meet will be swum under Swimming New Zealand (SNZ)/World Aquatic rules except where local rules and conditions apply.
- 2.All events will be swum as timed finals with over the top starts.
- 3.Self-marshalling will operate throughout the meet.
- 4. This meet is open to financial SNZ registered competitive swimmers (including para swimmers) aged 12 years and over. Overseas competitors may compete subject to providing a signed Travel Authorisation Form/Letter from their national federation.
- 5.Entries open at 7:00am on 12 April 2025, closing at 11:59am, Monday 5 May 2025. Late entries will not be accepted.
- 6. One-off entry fee of \$15.00 to enter the meet. Entries and payment via the SNZ database only.
- 7. The organisers reserve the right to amend the programme if necessary, and to restrict entries.
- 8. There will be no refunds for withdrawals after entries have closed.
- 9. Withdrawals before the meet can be emailed to[°] events@swim.co.nz by 5pm Thursday 8th May 2025. Withdrawls after this time are to be via a withdrawl form at the recorder's desk at the venue 45 minutes before the start of the meet.
- Initial psych sheets will be posted on the Swimming Wellington (SW) website on the Monday 5 May and programmes finialised at midday Friday 9 May.
- 11.All Participants must agree to comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Rules.
- 12. By entering this meet, swimmers agree to allow images (e.g. photography, video, etc.) to be taken by accredited media approved by SW in accordance with the SNZ Member Protection Policy. Club photographers should seek prior approval from the Meet organiser prior to the stat of the meet, as per the Swimming Wellington Photography Policy.
- 13. Strapping of muscles/joints is not permitted unless supported by a doctor or physio certificate and sighted by the Technical Director prior to the session.
- 14. Protests shall be lodged as per SNZ policy 008 accompanied with the \$100 cash.

Meet Specific Information

- 1. Swimmers may enter either the 1500m or 800m event with a NT ONLY if they have met the 400m Freestyle qualifying times of 5:50.00 for males and 6:00.00 for females (times to be held in the SNZ database). Swimmers cannot place in the 800m event with a split time from the 1500m event.
- 2. Age as at day of meet. All events will be scored in the following age groups for both male & female: 12, 13 14, 15, 16, 17+.
- 3. Age group points will be earned as 20, 14, 10, 7, 6, 5,4, 3, 2, 1 for first to tenth inclusive and will be added to the 2025 Swimming Wellington Short Course Championships.
- 4.A swimmer can not place in the 800m event with a split time from their 1500m.
- 5. Medals will be presented to the top 3 swimmers placing in each age group.
- 6. Medals will be presented throughout the meet Club uniform tops for medal presentations. Same gender substitutes permitted.

Warm Up Procedure

Warm-up duration: 40 minutes

All Lanes: General Swimming with feet first entry, unless specified.

Lanes 0/1 & 8/9: To become dive lanes at 5.15pm.

Lane 2: Designated pace lane.

Programmes pool will be available for warm down.

Club & Spectator Information

- 1. There will be no allocated seating for this meet.
- 2. Entry fee is \$3.00 for spectators 16 years and over.
- 3. The (SNZ) Code of Conduct and Media and Photography position statement in the Member Protection Policy applies to all spectators and competitors entering Coastlands Aquatic Centre. The Policy can be found on the SNZ website <u>here.</u>
- 4. Programmes will be available online on the Swimming Wellington website by Friday 9th May 2025 and on Meet Mobile. There will be no printed programmes available.
- 5. Entry for nominated Team Coaches & Team Managers will be; 1–10 Swimmers (1) coach and (1) team manager 11-20 (2) coaches and (2) team managers 21-35+ (3) coaches and (3) team managers.
- 6. Coaches must display their NZSCTA cards throughout the meet. Team Managers must show passes at the door. Team Managers & Coaches to provide their own programmes.
- 7. Results will be on Meet Mobile. Note these are unofficial times until signed off by the referee.
- 8. Disqualifications will be announced. DQ forms and can be viewed at the recorders desk.
- 9. All participating Swim Wellington clubs will be required to provide volunteers for door, runner and medal roles.
- 10. The organisers will not be liable for any loss or damage during the period of the meet.

Officials Information

All participating Swimming Wellington clubs are required to provide technical officials for the meet. RTOP will send this request to clubs. Officials are to bring their own water bottles.

All Qualified officials are required to have a current SNZ police vet recorded on SNZ database.

Officials (including timekeepers and duty clubs volunteers) are required to sign in on entry.

There will be an officials meeting in the meeting room 20 minutes prior to the start.
