MEET CONDITIONS

1. This **National Qualifier** will be swum **Short Course** and is open to SNZ registered, **Club & Competitive** swimmers.

 The meet will be swum under SNZ, World Aquatics and local rules. Quantum timing system will be used.
All events will be swum as mixed races, slowest to fastest with over the top starts. The pool depth is

2.4m.

4. Warm up procedure

- Warm-up duration: 25 minutes
- Lanes 0 8: General Swimming with only feet first entry applicable in all lanes.
- Lanes 0/1 & 8/9: To become dive lanes at 4.45pm.
- Lane 2: designated pace lane
- Lane 9: Designated to para swimmers (if any) between 4.30– 4.45pm.

5. Age is at 8 June 2024. No times (NT) will be accepted. Swimmers may enter a **maximum of 5** events.

6. Classified para swimmers (including those with provisional classification) are eligible to compete at this meet. Para swimmers are requested to report to the Technical Director prior to the warm-up.

7. Entries and payments will be via Fastlane. Entries close at 23:59.59 on Sunday 2 June 2024.

8. Late entries will not be accepted.

10. The Organisers reserve the right to restrict entries, combine events or alter the programme.

11. Entry fees are \$10 per event, payment online by Credit or Debit Card on SNZ's Fastlane.

12. Withdrawals – email to <u>racesec@otaki-titans.com</u> by 5pm Thursday 6th June or with the recorder at the venue by 4:15pm

13. There will be no refunds for withdrawals after entries close.

14. Marshalling will be next to the toddler paddling pool.

15. Entry for spectators is gold coin koha. No spectator programmes available at the meet.

16. Seating is limited – seating for swimmers will be on the bleachers and spectator seating on the right as you enter the pool. If the pool reaches capacity entry will be restricted to swimmers, team managers, coaches and people involved in the running of the meet.

17. Programmes for nominated coaches & team managers will be; 1–10 swimmers [2], 11-20 [3], 21+ [4].

18. Clubs are required to provide at least 1 IOT and 1 timekeeper. Please send names to:

otakisc@gmail.com no later than Monday 1 June 2024.

19. Strapping of muscles and joints is not permitted unless sighted and approved by the Technical Director prior to the meet, supported by a doctor's/physio's certificate.

20. Protests may be submitted in accordance with SNZ Policy 008 (to the referee in writing on the SNZ protest form by the team manager within 30 minutes following the conclusion of the respective event). The protest must be accompanied with \$100 (cash).

21. The Organisers will not be liable for any loss or damage during the period of the meet. All participants must agree to comply with the Sports' Anti-Doping Rules.

22. Participants who have entered this event agree to allow images to be taken by accredited media approved by Swimming Wellington. Images are only to be used for legitimate purposes by SW or host Club in accordance with the SNZ Member Protection Policy.
