Conditions of Entry

- Meet will be swum short course under SNZ /World Aquatics rules and local rules. Para swimmers are eligible to compete at this meet and shall compete under WPS swimming rules.
- The Championships are open to Competitive, Club and Recreational swimmers.
- Age as at 16th September 2023. Clubs can enter multiple teams for each event.
- Swimming-up an age is permitted in all events.
 Swim-up swimmers must be advised via email to louise@swimwn.co.nz at time of entry.
 Swim-ups in Events 1 and 23 are only permitted where a club has no swimmers in a specific age/gender group.
 Swimmers may swim in both age group and open events.
- Age groups for Events 1 and 23 are 9/under, 10/11, 12/13, 14/15, 16/over.
- Flying Squadron (Event 23) swimming order must be youngest first to oldest last, genders to alternate with females starting followed by males. Entries to be submitted to louise@swimwn.co.nz
- The minimum age for Golden Oldies is 30 years. No other restrictions apply.
- The meet will be marshalled.
- All events must have submitted names and times when entries are made. Any changes to relays must be submitted by 9pm on Thursday 14th September 2023 to louise@swimwn.co.nz or at the pool with the Recorder at least 50 minutes (4.40pm) before the meet starts.
- Entries open on Wednesday 16th August and close on Monday 11th September at 23:59:59 – late entries will not be accepted. All entries are to be submitted online via the SNZ online portal by the Club Administrator/Race Secretary.
- Entry fees of \$25 per team per event, except for Golden Oldies which will be free. Teams will be invoiced by C.O.B, Friday 15th September, and must be paid by C.O.B. Tuesday 19th September. Direct bank deposit or electronic payments can be made to; WPT 03-0502-0166158-00.
- There will be no refunds for teams who withdraw after entries close.
- Medals for places 1-3 inclusive will be presented throughout the meet with event trophies. Current trophy holders are to ensure that the trophies are cleaned, engraved, and returned to SW offices, at Pelorus House, 93 Hutt Park Road, Seaview by 25th August 2023.
- All participants must agree to comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Rules.
- Classified para swimmers (including provisional classification) are eligible to compete at this meet.
 Para swimmers are requested to report to the Technical Director prior to the warm-up.

- Strapping of muscles/joints is not permitted unless supported by a doctor or physio certificate and sighted by the Technical Director prior to the start of the meet.
- By entering this event swimmers agree to allow images (e.g. photography, video, etc.) to be taken by accredited media approved by Swimming Wellington. Images are only to be used for legitimate purposes by Swim Wellington in accordance with the SNZ Member Protection Policy.
- Swimming Wellington reserves the right to restrict entries, combine events or alter the programme and will not be liable for any loss, damage or injury that may occur at this meet.
- Protests shall be lodged as per SNZ policy 008 along with \$100 cash.

Club / Spectator Information

- Duty Club requirements will be advised by Swimming Wellington.
- There will be a Team Manager's meeting at 4.45pm.
- Entry for all swimmers, officials, team managers and coaches will be via main entrance. Swimmers to present Swimming Wellington pool entry passes. Coaches are to display their NZSCTA cards throughout the meet. Officials (including timekeepers and duty clubs' volunteers) are required to sign in on entry.
- Coach/Managers at a ratio of 1 per 4 Club Teams will be free on sign in at the door.
- Spectator's entry fee will be \$3.
- The Swimming NZ Code of Conduct and Media and Photography position statement in the Swimming NZ Member Protection Policy Manual apply to all spectators entering Coastlands Aquatic Centre. The Manual can be found on the Swimming NZ website here.
- Programmes will be made available online on the Swimming Wellington website on Friday 15th September, at 5pm. There will be no printed programmes available.
- Participating clubs will be required to provide officials for this meet. A request for officials will be sent by the SW Regional Technical Officials Panel (RTOP). Officials to bring own water bottle.
- There will be an officials' meeting at 5.10pm

Lanes 0/1 & 8/9: To become dive lanes at 5.15pm.
